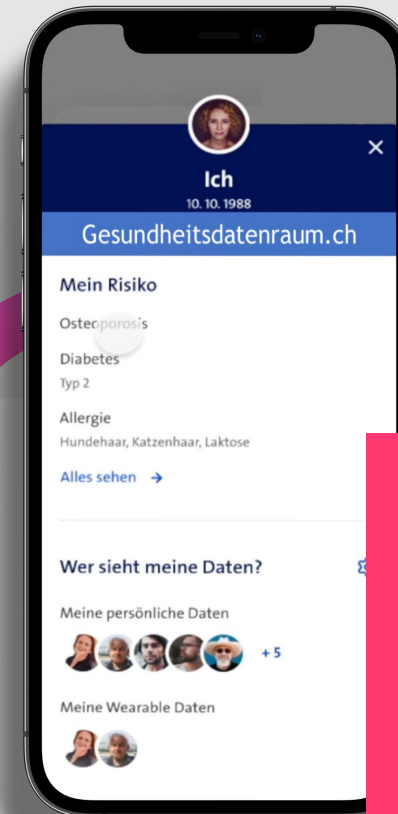

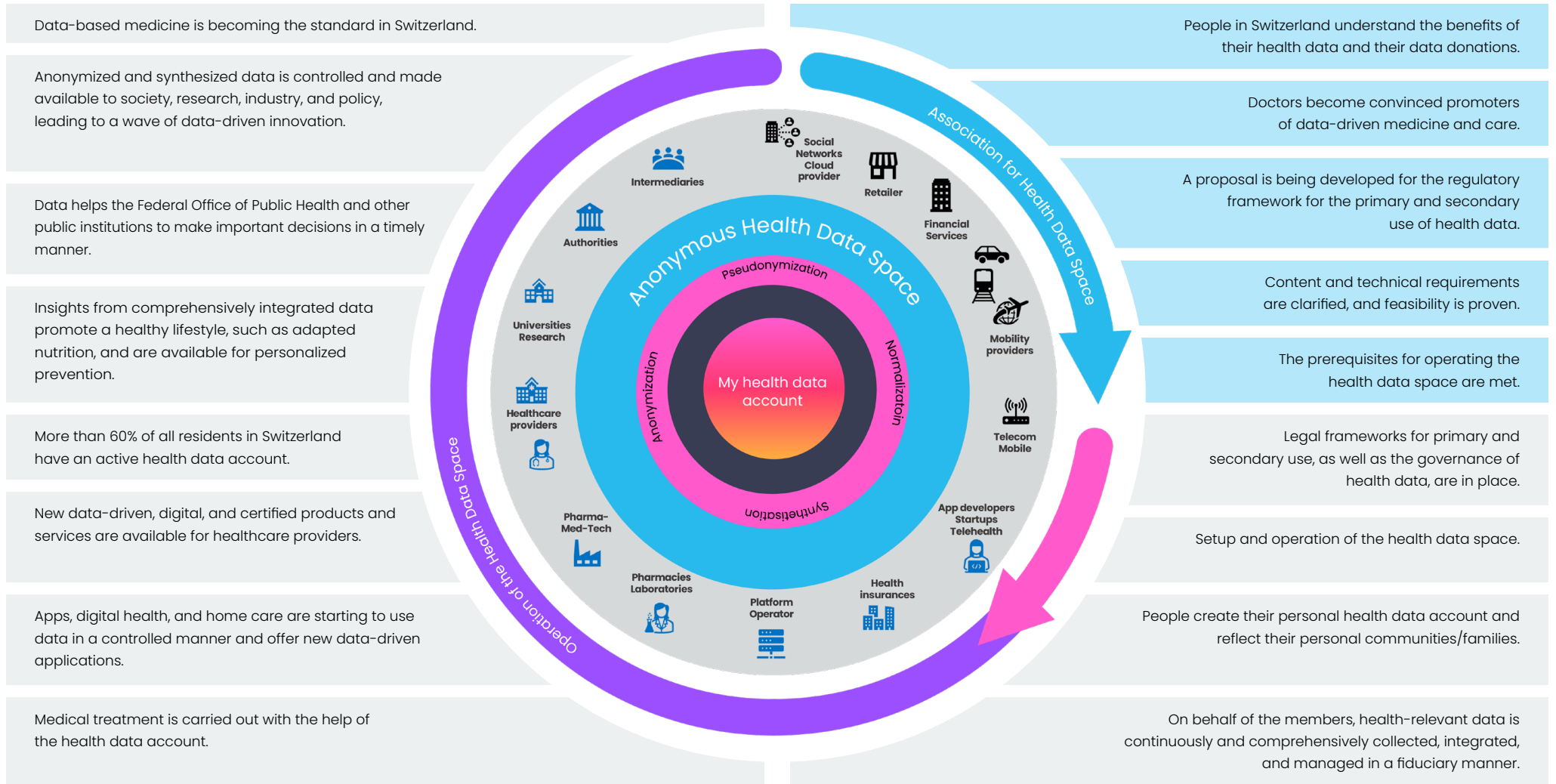

The Swiss Health Data Space (SHDS) puts the human at the center, and is the basis for data-driven medical care and research.



Data-based medicine is becoming the standard in Switzerland.

Anonymized and synthesized data is controlled and made available to society, research, industry, and policy, leading to a wave of data-driven innovation.

Data helps the Federal Office of Public Health and other public institutions to make important decisions in a timely manner.

Insights from comprehensively integrated data promote a healthy lifestyle, such as adapted nutrition, and are available for personalized prevention.

More than 60% of all residents in Switzerland have an active health data account.

New data-driven, digital, and certified products and services are available for healthcare providers.

Apps, digital health, and home care are starting to use data in a controlled manner and offer new data-driven applications.

Medical treatment is carried out with the help of the health data account.

People in Switzerland understand the benefits of their health data and their data donations.

Doctors become convinced promoters of data-driven medicine and care.

A proposal is being developed for the regulatory framework for the primary and secondary use of health data.

Content and technical requirements are clarified, and feasibility is proven.

The prerequisites for operating the health data space are met.

Legal frameworks for primary and secondary use, as well as the governance of health data, are in place.
